Policy Name: Transportation Within Attendance Areas

Legal Reference:

The Board of Education believes in establishing clearly defined bus transportation services by designated attendance area.

Guidelines:

1. The establishment, alteration, or cancellation of bus routes shall be determined by the Supervisor of Transportation.
2. Students living within an urban attendance area may be eligible for transportation where a natural or man-made barrier on the route is determined to be hazardous to student safety.
3. Urban transportation to urban high schools is the responsibility of students and their parents.
4. A transportation fee for Saskatchewan Rivers School Division high school students equal to the monthly student city transit fee may be levied in urban areas where city transit service is not available.
5. Students living in rural attendance areas receive Kindergarten to Grade 12 transportation at no cost provided they are attending school in their designated attendance area.
6. Transportation within the division by external jurisdictions may be permitted in exceptional circumstances.
