ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

1. The principal or designate, in consultation with consultants and staff members, shall determine and document the need for such programs.
2. A thorough information program shall be in place for informing affected parents about the programs.
3. Approval of the parent/guardian of student candidates for such special programming shall be requested before they are entered into such programs.
4. Schools shall adhere to the regulations as outlined, in the Saskatchewan Learning document entitled "*Policies and Procedures for Locally Developed and Modified Courses of Study, and Alternative Education Programs*" current edition.
5. The designated Superintendent shall review and approve such programming.
