## **Optional Supply Suggestions** (to help with organization):

- <u>Zippered Binders</u>- These are an expensive investment, but are essential for students that have a hard time keeping materials together. They are usually well-made and can be used year after year.
- <u>Pencil case and writing materials</u> (pens, pencils erasers, highlighters, reinforcements) to go in each <u>binder</u>. –The pencil cases have the holes allow them to remain in the binder. This helps the students make sure they have the necessary materials for each class.
- <u>Colour coordinated materials</u>- Binders and accompanying material can be colour coordinated so that a student can easily identify the proper materials for each class.
- <u>Locker shelves</u>- the lockers are very small and difficult to keep organized. Locker shelves help to keep things organized.
- <u>Label binders</u> with name and subject title (on the front and along the **spine**).
- $\circ$   $\,$  Magnets for the inside of the locker door.
- <u>Sticky notes</u>- for the inside of the locker door- for little reminders.
- Magnetic baskets for the inside of the locker door, to keep extra pens, pencils, and other materials.
