<ul style="list-style-type: none"> daily attendance is compulsory for classes where there is instruction each student will work at his/her own rate in modular classes but attendance is advised as there will be a teacher/facilitator and reference materials available students may take more than one class but one is the recommended amount accredited teachers will teach the grade twelve classes <div data-bbox="228 1438 797 1619" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p align="center">NOTE: THE FIRST DAY OF CLASSES BEGINS AT CARLTON AT 8:00 AM. IF YOU HAVE NOT PREVIOUSLY REGISTERED PLEASE COME TO THE SCHOOL AT 7:30A.M.</p> </div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Grade 10 and 11 Students:</u> must have previously taken the course unless you are an adult student based on performance during the year, school principals will recommend a student for Summer School. (Note: students should have remained in the class for the year (or semester) and have achieved 35% or higher.) <u>Math 10, 20 students need to bring a report card showing what outcomes they need.</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Grade 12 Students</u> grade 12 students may take a course for the first time at Summer School , providing they have the necessary pre-requisite Adult students welcome and do not require pre-requisites
