<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>students must complete the Summer School registration form on or before 12:00 noon, <b>June 29, 2012</b></li> <li>the form may be faxed or mailed to Carlton Comprehensive High School (mailing information is on the registration form)</li> </ul>	<p><b>Fees must be paid on or before July 3, 2012</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>make cheques payable to <b>Saskatchewan Rivers School Division No. 119</b></li> <li>Cost of each class is \$350.00</li> <li>A non-refundable fee of \$100 must accompany applications. Fees are non-refundable after registration.</li> </ul>

The Summer School Program	Prerequisites	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>daily attendance is compulsory for Math 30A, 30B, and 30C and Chemistry 30 (if instructed)</li> <li>students will complete <b>modules</b> of work in all subjects except math and Chemistry 30 (if #'s are high enough)</li> <li>each student will work at his/her own rate in modular classes</li> <li>students will receive direct instruction in math</li> <li>students may take a maximum of two classes (we recommend one only)</li> <li>accredited teachers will teach the grade twelve classes</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><u>Grade 9, 10 and 11 Students:</u></li> <li>must have previously taken the course</li> <li>based on performance during the year, school principals will recommend a student for Summer School. <b>(Note: students should have remained in the class for the year (or semester) and have achieved 35% or higher.)</b></li> <li><u>Math 10, 20 students need to bring a report card showing what outcomes they need.</u></li> <li><u>Grade 12 Students</u></li> <li>grade 12 students may take a course for the first time at Summer School, providing they have the necessary pre-requisite</li> <li>the official school signature and stamp on the registration form verifies that the pre-requisites have been successfully completed</li> <li><b>Adult students welcome and do not require pre-requisites</b></li> </ul>
