(Hereinafter called the "Union")

LIBRARY CLERK WAGES AND HOURS OF WORK

It is mutually agreed that:

1. The Library Clerk classification shall be effective as of January 1, 2010;
2. The Library Clerk wages and hours of work shall be as per the Library Assistant wages and hours of work; and
3. Library Assistants who are currently employed as of January 1, 2010, excluding those who are in split Library Assistant / Secretary 1 positions, shall be:
  - a) Grandfathered into the Library Clerk classification and deemed qualified; and
  - b) Eligible to apply for vacant positions within the Library Clerk Classification


