Saskatchewan Rivers Public School Division is inviting applications for the position of **Learning Consultant**. The Consultant will provide leadership in supporting student achievement of PreK to 12 provincial curricula outcomes with an emphasis on First Nations, Inuit and Métis content, perspectives and ways of knowing. He or she will also be instrumental in developing and sustaining partnerships with families, Elders, First Nations and with Métis organizations. This is a full time position for a four year term with duties to commence on August 27, 2016 and the possibility to reapply upon completion of the term.

- Demonstrated commitment to creating culturally responsive learning environments

- Work towards a Master's degree in Education or associated field would be an asset
