Student Support Services

Consultants

- Consult regarding student behavioral, socialemotional, and/or academic concerns
- Facilitate referrals to in-division and out-of-division services
- Support school staff when working with parents and outside agencies
- Collaborate with school staff, families and outside agencies in order to determine appropriate educational programs for students
- Facilitate support for traumatic incidents

Behaviour Coach

Works collaboratively with teachers and administrators for students exhibiting emotional and behavioural challenges

Educational Psychologists

- Assist students who are displaying difficulties with learning and/or behavior
- Facilitate support for traumatic incidents
- Participate as active members of the school Threat Assessment Team
- Provide in-service for parents, teachers and other school staff
- Complete psycho-educational assessments
- Participate in the Child and Youth Development Clinic (CDC – a multidisciplinary/interagency diagnostic team)
- Facilitate PLC groups
- Assist students to acquire technology to support their learning
- Suggest resources and ideas for implementation in the classroom
