Non-Violent Crisis Intervention Training

(1.5 days)

This workshop follows the teaching sequence: Demonstrate-Participate-Explain. Therefore, please come dressed in comfortable clothes that do not restrict movement (ex: sweat pants, t-shirts, running shoes, etc.)

Overview: NVCI focuses on providing the best possible Care, Welfare, Safety and Security to staff members and those in their care. The emphasis is on prevention, de-escalation, and the use of physical intervention only as a last resort when an individual presents a danger to self or others. Staff members will be provided with an effective framework for decision making and problem solving to prevent, de-escalate, and safely respond to disruptive or assaultive behavior.

- Are able to prevent and de-escalate hostile and potentially violent behaviors
 - Are aware of nonverbal communication and react appropriately
 - Are able to avoid power struggles and set appropriate limits
 - Have the skills to manage oneself and others safely during a crisis situation
