Non-Violent Crisis Intervention Training (REFRESHER)

This formal refresher training is for those who have been trained in NVCI training in the past year and would like to keep up their certification.

Overview: NVCI focuses on providing the best possible Care, Welfare, Safety and Security to staff members and those in their care. The emphasis is on prevention, de-escalation, and the use of physical intervention only as a last resort when an individual presents a danger to self or others. Staff members will be provided with an effective framework for decision making and problem solving to prevent, de-escalate, and safely respond to disruptive or assaultive behavior.
