Reflecting on our first year of the expansion project, we are proud of our steadfast commitment to establishing a high-quality and rigorous French Immersion program. - Engaging cultural activities to support language development:
 - Crêpe-making, puppet shows, guest speakers including various authors/illustrators, Family Literacy Night with French Language activities, 'Little Green Thumbs' in grade 1 classes and much more.
- School-wide fun and relevant assemblies to celebrate student achievement, progress and individual reading goals.
- Availability and integration of technology including Chrome books, Ipads, laptops, SMART boards, Sound Field Systems, document cameras, and more.

Positive relationships are also fundamental to our school vision and mission. It is through school and family relationships that we are able to provide a welcoming, safe and meaningful learning environment for our students so they can achieve their fullest academic, physical, social and emotional potential.
