- __self-monitor comprehension
- __adjust rate and/or strategy

After Reading

- __recall, paraphrase, summarize, synthesize
- __reflect and interpret
- __evaluate (respond critically)
- __evaluate craft and technique
- __respond personally with support

from text

__read again to deepen understanding and pleasure
