- At Wesmor learning is joyful, culture is affirmed, and students are given real choices for their futures.
- Wesmor focuses on creating a caring, respectful, learning community where students' feel valued and respected.
- Our Military Coop program provides students with Military Studies 30 and Leadership 30 credits, as well as the opportunity to explore the possibility of a career in the Canadian Armed Forces, through real-life experiences and training.
- Land-based learning happens through Indigenous cultural learning experiences, as well as our Wild Life Management courses.
- Wesmor embeds culturally responsive education as we learn in class, as we learn from Elders and with each other, every day.
- Our Emergency Services Training Program provides youth with professional training that prepares them for employment and encourages them to volunteer in the public safety area such as policing and fire safety.
- At Wesmor students with diverse learning styles and needs learn from hands-on activities and real-life experiences
- The block system lets students focus on just two classes per day: one class in the morning and one class in the afternoon.
- Students can earn 10 credits in 5 Blocks, each school year.

- Staff at Wesmor support students as they work to reach their goals
- Wesmor has a variety of clubs and teams, providing many ways to be involved in extra-curricular activities.
