Optional Supply Suggestions (to help with organization):

- Zippered Binders- These are an expensive investment, but are essential for students that have a hard time keeping materials together. They are usually well-made and can be used year after year.
- Pencil case and writing materials (pens, pencils erasers, highlighters, reinforcements) to go in each binder. –The pencil cases have the holes allow them to remain in the binder. This helps the students make sure they have the necessary materials for each class.
- Colour coordinated materials- Binders and accompanying material can be colour coordinated so that a student can easily identify the proper materials for each class.
- Locker shelves- the lockers are very small and difficult to keep organized. Locker shelves help to keep things organized.
- Label binders with name and subject title (on the front and along the **spine**).
- Magnets for the inside of the locker door.
- Sticky notes- for the inside of the locker door- for little reminders.
- Magnetic baskets for the inside of the locker door, to keep extra pens, pencils, and other materials.
