Linkage Meeting with Separate School Division

Trustees had the opportunity to participate in a collaborative meeting with representatives from the Separate School Division. The discussion focused on strengthening relationships and identifying shared priorities that support students, families, and communities across both divisions. Trustees also discussed the importance of advocacy at the provincial level. The meeting reinforced a strong commitment from both boards to work together where possible, share promising practices, and continue advocating for high-quality education. Trustees expressed appreciation for the open dialogue and the opportunity to build alignment on issues that impact all students in the region.

Provincial Budget Reactions

Trustees welcomed the recently announced provincial budget, as positive news for students, staff, and communities. The Board was especially pleased to see the inclusion of funding for the replacement school in Shellbrook, an investment that has been the top priority capital request for the Board for more than a decade. This commitment marks a significant milestone as the first new school built in the division since 2004, when Vincent Massey underwent a replacement build. This commitment to replacing an aging facility reflects the importance of continued provincial support to meet the needs of growing and evolving school communities.

Student Celebrations

Many events were celebrated across SRPSD schools this month. Carlton girls and boys basketball teams are heading to Hoopla; notably, our boys team is ranked 2nd in the province as they head into the tournament. Our French Immersion students took part in the SRPSD Carnival and Prince Albert's Tintamarre Festival, celebrating French culture and language in our community. The Prince Albert Music Festival is wrapping up, with many SRPSD students showcasing their talents in band, choir, and individual musical pursuits. A huge thank you goes out to our coaches, teachers, and band directors for the work they put in to allow our students to shine!
