SCC Gathering

The Board is gathering with School Community Councils this week. The meeting will give SCC's an opportunity to share their celebrations and concerns with the Board. SCC's will also have meaningful conversations with Board members around Board generated topics such as budget priorities in the strategic plan, improving parent engagement at the school and Board level, and what SCC's could do to support the departmental advocacy work of our SRSC. The Board, and SCC's will also take part in a presentation on the effects of cell phone use in schools on learning. The Board is honoured to have this time with SCC members to come together in the spirit of learning.

Enterprise Risk Management

Director Robert Bratvold presented the Enterprise Risk Management report at the most recent Board meeting. The report is generated through enterprise risk management exercises at the Senior Administrative table. Risks to the school division are identified and ranked by individual members of the Senior Administration team for both the likelihood and the impact of the risk. These are then discussed, and processed into a risk matrix. The Board is committed to risk monitoring and mitigations for lower level risks, and reporting and mitigation for higher level risks. These plans, and mitigation reports were shared for the first time at the most recent meeting. Bratvold informed the Board that this is important work, but also a learning process for the Senior Administration Team.
