## Board Advocacy Successes

The Board has achieved significant progress on its Advocacy Plan this year, completing the majority of planned actions and strategies while strengthening key relationships and advancing priority areas. Notable successes include direct engagement with two MLAs and the Minister of Education to advocate for funding for vulnerable students, supports for learning, and major capital projects; participation in partnership meetings with municipal and education sector partners; and maintaining strong alignment between advocacy work and the Strategic Plan. Engagement efforts have been well received by stakeholders, including positive feedback on SCC/SRSC gatherings, and continued commitment to Truth and Reconciliation. The Board has also enhanced communication and visibility through growth in social media and the addition of a LinkedIn presence, while expanding the Elders Council, supporting SCC and student voice, and ensuring consistent sharing of key messages with the community.

## TRC Calls to Action, Community Engagement and Transportation Reports

At their recent meeting, the Board received several important annual updates. Superintendent Jennifer Hingley shared highlights of the division's response to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls to Action, including growing land-based learning opportunities and ongoing work in anti-racist/anti-bias education with both leadership and school staff. Superintendent Garette Tebay presented the Community Engagement Annual Report, outlining partnerships with School Community Councils, the Saskatchewan Rivers Students for Change, and various community organizations, along with strong growth in communications and social media engagement. The Board also reviewed the Transportation Report presented by CFO Jerrold Pidborochynski, which summarized student transportation services across the Division and affirmed the Division's continued commitment to safe, efficient service for all students.

## Farewell to Retirees, and Best Wishes for the Summer

The Board of Education proudly marked the close of another successful school year, celebrating the many accomplishments of students, staff, and schools across the division. Earlier this month, the Board hosted its annual Recognition event to honour long-serving and retiring staff, expressing heartfelt appreciation for the lasting impact these dedicated individuals have made in supporting learners and strengthening school communities.
