


Our Assessment Goal




Edsby App

When you download the app you will need to enter:




Resetting Passwords - Parents





Parent Planned Absences

The arrows move the news from left to right.




Notifications

When you are on your computer.


This can be done by clicking the drop-down arrow next to your name in Edsby and selecting Settings from the menu.



Your choices are **Never** or **Daily**.








Edsby Messages

Here you can view previous conversations as well as compose a new message by clicking the icon in the top right.




Teachers & Students will appreciate your feedback.






Classes & Students Grades



Clicking on “My Work” for each class will show you, your child's upcoming assessments and any grades your teacher has shared.

You can also click on the name of the class for journal entries and notes.



Grade 1-9 Grading Scale

When you log into Edsby and look at your child's "My Work" you will see IG, IE, BE, AP, ME, or EX.

EX - Exemplary	Evidence indicates in-depth understanding, demonstration or application of the strand
ME - Meeting	Evidence indicates understanding, demonstration or application of the strand
AP - Approaching	Evidence indicates progression towards understanding, demonstration or application of the strand
BE - Beginning	Evidence indicates initial understanding, demonstration or application of the strand
IE - Insufficient Evidence	The student has not yet demonstrated enough evidence for reporting purpose.
IG - Individualized Goals	The student demonstrates understanding of outcomes that are adjusted in number and complexity as discussed with parents/ guardian prior to this report.


