Conversion Table Guidelines:

- The conversion table is applied only when a percentage mark is required (end of term for reporting purposes as required by the Ministry or as needed earlier for students applying for scholarships).
- You can pass a course without passing all of the outcomes.
- Summative results are used to determine the mark. If there is not enough summative information to determine levels of understanding, then formative results may be taken into consideration.
- Only the most recent outcome rubric score is used as a part of the conversion process as it will be the most up to date account of the student's achievement level reached for that particular outcome.
