The candidate will have a proven track record of broad-based educational leadership with a focus on improving results for a diverse student population, advancing First Nations and Métis education, and a purposeful presence in schools.

As a leader, the candidate will be committed to a child-centered educational philosophy in keeping with the Division's mission to strive for excellence in education and to seek to maximize each child's unique learning ability. The candidate will maintain strong relationships with the Board, the staff, educational stakeholders, and other community partners. Experience in supporting both urban and rural schools is an asset.

The candidate will provide leadership for 8,500 students in 33 schools located in the City of Prince Albert and rural areas in all four directions from the city, ranging from Big River to St. Louis to Kinistino to Meath Park to Christopher Lake, and many points in between. The Division maintains a high commitment to all areas of programming to meet provincial requirements and local interests including Cree and Michif Language Programs, French Immersion, EAL programming and specialized supports for students with complex intensive needs.
