



INTENSIVE SUPPORTS COACH Inclusive Learning Team

Saskatchewan Rivers Public School Division (SRPSD) is inviting applications for the position of Intensive Supports Coach. This is a full-time position with duties to commence at the start of the 2022-23 school year. The position will be a year-by-year teaching assignment with a maximum of a four-year term. Those that apply will also be considered for the Intensive Supports Coach and Consultant Pool for future considerations.

Under the supervision of a superintendent of schools, the Coach will be a key member of the Inclusive Learning Team of consultants and coaches. With a focus on the values and principles of inclusive education, the Coach will support classroom teachers who work with students demonstrating diverse and complex learning needs.

Education and Experience

- Valid teaching certificate in Saskatchewan
- Minimum of five years of teaching experience
- Graduate level education is beneficial, especially in the area of Inclusive Education
- Proficient understanding of the Response To Intervention model of supporting student needs
- Proficient understanding of First Nations and Metis ways of knowing
- Demonstrated commitment to creating culturally responsive learning environments
- Demonstrated effective leadership in a PLC
- Demonstrated ability to collaborate with colleagues, educators and parents

- Commitment to inclusive education that supports student needs and strengths
- Belief that all students can achieve high standards
- Effective interpersonal and relationship skills
- Effective oral and written communication skills
- Flexible, willing to pursue new challenges, and tolerant of ambiguity
- Self-directed, organized, and efficient time management
- Demonstrated skills in collaborative problem solving
- Dedicated to continuous learning, evidence-based strategies, and knowledge sharing
- Mastery level understanding of curricula, instruction, and assessment practices
- Mastery level understanding of differentiation
- Mastery level of understanding of behaviour management strategies
