What does the SWIS worker do?

- Helps determine needs of newcomer students and families.
- Connect newcomer families and students to resources in the school and community to support settlement.
- Support family involvement in the student's school life.
- Helps with access to services and resources when there are barriers due to language.
- Increase school and community awareness and involvement in the integration process of newcomers.
- Promotes cultural diversity by informing the school community of newcomer topics.



Who is the SWIS Program available to?

SWIS services are provided in all Prince Albert School Divisions.

A SWIS referral form must be completed in order for a student or family to receive SWIS services. This form can be completed at your school's general office or by contacting the SWIS intake worker.
